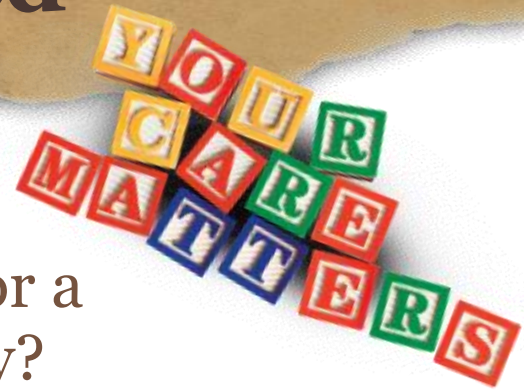


Make a **difference** in your community: **foster parents needed**
