#### What happens next?

If these plans are approved then the project will move into detailed design (this involves the creation of the technical construction drawings) and then a tender process. At this stage we are anticipating a decision to be made in May 2017 by the Community Board.

The project team are hoping that construction works at both sites will happen at the same time and will be aiming for the construction to be completed by December 2017. However this is subject to a number of factors such as consent approvals (if required), contractor availability, weather and ground conditions.

#### Halswell Domain Skate and **Recreation Park**

Please refer to the concept designs included in the attached insert for images. The key elements of this design include.

- Skate elements including a skate bowl with double pocket, rising quarter pipe with kerb lip, mini ramp, tear drop flyover, pyramid hip, learner ledge and rails.
- Pump track with berms and rollovers.
- Four fitness equipment items (two per station).
- Access pathway.
- Informal seating
- Shade shelter.
- Landscaped mounds and use of coloured concrete in places to blend the design into the environment.
