What's a tall tale?

It's a story that is obviously untrue or impossible. But this doesn't mean that it must be simply nonsense. A tall tale encourages readers to suspend disbelief for the sake of a good read!

Some ways to suspend disbelief:

- create an extraordinary happening for an ordinary character in a normal setting
- create an extraordinary character in a normal setting
- surprise the reader, but don't bamboozle!
- create a plot that makes some kind of sense, even if it's not normal sense
- try to convince your readers that the story could possibly be true
- tall tales can be funny, scary, sad, happy, entertaining or instructional
- think of an ending that is subtle and clever

Make it fun for your readers!

And to make it fun for the judges, please

- type your work in Times New Roman on white A4 paper
- use paragraphs and "double quotation marks" and check your spelling properly!

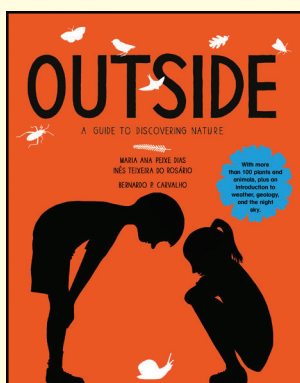

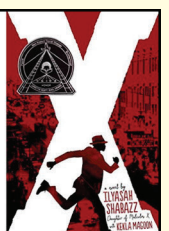
